Wroxall Primary is an inclusive school that welcomes children from all backgrounds and abilities. Applications are made directly to the local authority. The only restriction placed on entry by the local authority is number of pupils, our current Pupil Allocation Number (PAN) is 30 per class group.

If the year group you apply for is full, your child can be put on our waiting list and you will be informed when a space becomes available. Parents may appeal against a decision to refuse entry; they can do so by appealing to the Isle of Wight Council.

The Isle of Wight School Admissions Policy is set in accordance with the School Admissions Code of Practice published by the Department for Education.

The Isle of Wight Council is the Admissions Authority for all Community and Voluntary Controlled schools on the Island.
